Mobile Phones

The 'Students Using Mobile Phones Policy' for all Victorian Government schools, introduced in 2020, requires students who bring a phone to school to have it switched off and securely stored during school hours, including recess and lunchtime.

In most cases it is best that children do not bring a phone to school at all. Those who genuinely need one will be required to have it locked in a secure location.

Roof Access Restrictions

A reminder that school staff are not permitted to access building roofs. We are required to hire specialist contractors to remove any objects from the roof due to new compliance requirements introduced last year.

Unfortunately, we often have student belongings such as balls, frisbees, toy planes and other items land on the roofs, and we are not able to retrieve them. For this reason, we encourage students to use school equipment and leave their personal items at home.

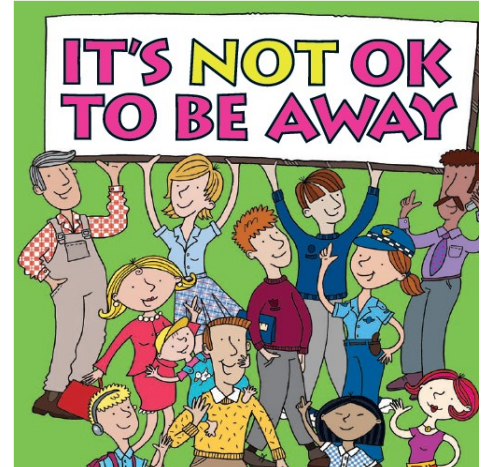
