Principals Report

Lolly/Drinks Purchases

I am concerned with the number of students purchasing high sugar/caffeine drinks and lollies prior to school starting, often from the Vary St Milk Bar.

I suspect many parents/caregivers are unaware their child is doing so. There is a clear link between the consumption of high sugar/caffeine drinks and lollies and an inability to focus at school. Many students find focus a challenge and this is exacerbated by poor diet. I would urge parents/caregivers to be mindful of their child's consumption of drinks and lollies.

Bessie Frood was an active member of the Morwell Netball Association who passed tragically in a motor vehicle accident in the 1980's. 
