Grade 6 Camp

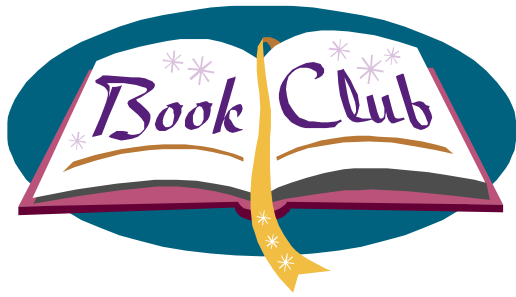
Our grade six students are currently attending The Summit camp which is situated near Trafalgar. Its pleasing the weather has cleared and the news so far is that they are having a great time.
