Food for Thought

(extract from research by Cynthia May) As part of a school Science project, a New Zealand teenager sat for some tests in reading, typing and mathematics, then went on a three day junk food diet; Coco Pops and Coke for breakfast, lollies for lunch and meat pies for dinner. Morwell Park Primary School Official

When he re-sat the tests he found his reading was 43% slower, his typing was reduced to half the usual speed and he solved maths problems more slowly.

Our brain is only 2% of our body but it consumes up to 30% of our energy. It seems there is a strong correlation between food intake and mental and behavioural performance....if we exercise, blood flow to the brain is increased so we are able to think more clearly.





Friday 30th August


All students will have an opportunity to purchase a gift for their Father/Special person from 8.45 till recess, with a variety of gifts ranging from \$1.00 to \$7.00.





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Ingredients


2 apples, peeled and grated 150gm butter 2 bananas 1 1/2 cup Wholemeal Self Raising Flour 2 eggs 2 tsp baking powder

Method

Preheat oven to 180 (160 fan-forced). Line a muffin tray with paper cases.

Put apple and butter in a saucepan and cook for 5 minutes until soft, then peel and mash bananas with the back of a fork (the riper they are the better).

Mix all ingredients together in a bowl. Spoon the mixture into the paper cases and bake for 20 minutes. Allow to cool before serving.
