Principals Report

School Photos

A reminder that school photos will be taken next Tuesday. Children are required to be in full school uniform for the photographs. All photos must be ordered online.

Vaccination Clinic

Interconnect Healthcare is operating a vaccination clinic here at school on June 7th. It will be open between 3.15 - 5.15 pm and operate from the school gym. School Medication

With the onset of the cold and wet weather we are seeing a number of children coming to school with medication. It is a legal requirement that parents/guardians deliver medication to the office and ensure they complete the necessary paperwork (available at the office). Staff are not permitted to administer medication to your child without the original medication label and a completed consent form.

Head Lice

Head Lice are common in school-aged children and are the most adaptable of creatures, they have survived living solely on humans for 10,000 years. You may be reassured to know that they are commonly found in places other than Morwell Park Primary School, especially given our school isn't 10,000 years old we can't claim them as our own!!!

Some reasons they have survived for so long are:

- The six legs of a louse end in a claw, allowing them to grip the hair.
- They detect vibration and can hide - (conditioner will help this problem).
- Head lice can 'hold' their breath for 20 minutes looking like they are dead.
- The eggs are attached to the hair with a 'glue' like substance. Studies conducted on 45 different products to dissolve the 'glue' showed nothing would dissolve it.

The good news...

We know where they live and we know how to find them. If you follow these steps at least once a week, the control of head lice in your home will be greatly improved.

- Step 1 - Comb inexpensive hair conditioner on to dry, brushed (detangled) hair, making it difficult for lice to grip the hair or run around;
- Step 2 - Wipe the conditioner from the comb onto a paper towel or tissue;
- Step 3 - Look on the tissue and on the comb for lice and eggs;
- Step 4 - If lice or eggs are found, the child should be treated.

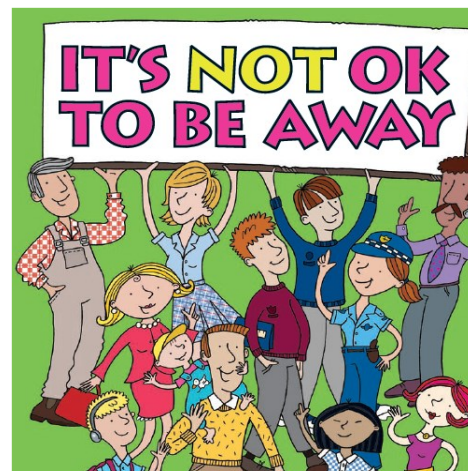

Minimising head lice outbreaks

Check weekly, treat quickly
and tell the school

Check the heads of everyone in your
house using conditioner and combing...

- at least once a week; or
- every two days if someone around you has head lice.

If you find head lice, treat and check for effectiveness.
Remember to notify the school.



BANANA & RASPBERRY MUFFINS

Ingredients

2 large bananas
1/4 teaspoon baking soda
1 egg
1 cup SR flour
1 tablespoon cocoa
1 cup frozen raspberries.

1 teaspoon vanilla essence
3/4 cup milk
1/3 cup canola oil
1 cup w/meal SR flour
1/4 cup sugar

Method

1. Pre-heat oven to 200C.
2. In a medium bowl, mash bananas with a fork and mix in vanilla essence.
3. Add the baking soda and milk.
4. In a separate bowl, lightly beat the eggs and add the oil, then add the banana mixture, stirring well.
5. In a large bowl, sift the flours and cocoa together, then add the sugar.
6. Make a well in the centre of the flour mix. Slowly add the liquid ingredients and the raspberries, then fold to combine. Be careful not to over stir.
7. Pour mixture directly into non-stick muffin trays, or line with paper cases, and bake for 20-25 mins.
8. Take muffins out of tray and allow to cool on cake rack.
