<u>NAPLAN</u>

Students in grades 3 and 5 have concluded their NAPLAN tests this week. While students' attitude towards NAPLAN varies and the value we place on the results also varies, the process itself does in my opinion serve a valuable purpose.

Being required to demonstrate skills and knowledge within a designated time frame is something we will all experience throughout our lifetime. The relatively low stakes environment of a NAPLAN test is a great opportunity for children to take tiny steps toward the challenges they will inevitably face is later life.



Wellbeing Wonders

This term some students have been involved in cooking for the breakfast club. We have been making fruit muffins, quiches and the students favourite Zucchini slice. This is the recipe for the Zucchini Slice, you might like to try it over the holidays.

Zucchini Slice

Ingredients:

400gms grated zucchini 5 eggs beaten 2/3 cup of cream OR skim milk 1 cup S.R Flour sifted 1 cup grated cheese 1/2 cup bacon diced

Method:

Combine all ingredients in a bowl and mix well. Pour mixture into a lined baking tray or square cake tin. Bake in oven 170 Fan forced OR 180f if not fan forced for approx. 40-45 minutes or until set and golden brown. Allow to cool for a few minutes before slicing. This slice can be eaten hot or cold and can be frozen once completely cool.
