Principals Report

Preps Full School Week
A big milestone for our Prep students... from Monday 2 March they will be attending school five days a week, including Fridays. They have settled in beautifully and are more than ready for the full week.

3.00pm End of Day Exit Arrangements
A reminder that our school grounds are not open public spaces, and we have processes in place to help keep everyone safe. As part of our Occupational Health and Safety requirements, all visitors are asked to sign in through reception.
At the end of the school day, we have noticed these processes are not always being followed as closely as they should be. To support a safe and smooth pick up, three gates are opened at 3.00pm. Gate 5 is on Vary Street near the milk bar, Gate 4 is at the rotunda via the Hourigan Road entrance, and Gate 1 is located at the bottom of the school near Waterhole Creek. Please make sure you have a clear plan with your child about which gate they will be collected from each day. If you wish to speak with your child's teacher, please do not enter via the gates, we ask that you sign in at reception.

Please Name Your Child's Belongings
Our lost property tub is already starting to fill up, and we are only in week 5. Uniforms, hats, lunchboxes and drink bottles all add up, and we would love to get them back to the right owners. If items are named, we can return them straight away. If not, they tend to sit there waiting to be claimed. A quick label can save you a replacement.

A reminder that Monday 9 March is a public holiday. The school will be closed for the day.

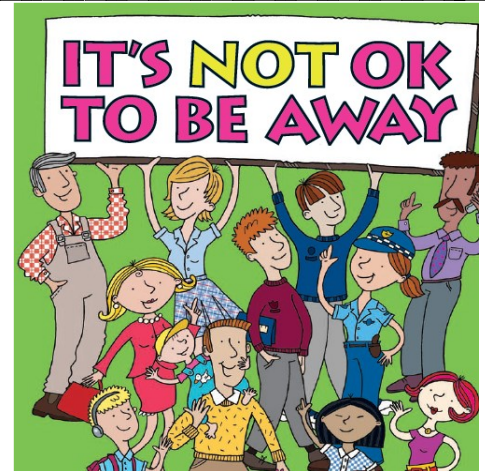
