Principals Report

<u>Changes to Photographing, Filming and Recording Students Policy</u>

Today, students will be bringing home an updated copy of our Photographing, Filming and Recording Students policy, along with a consent form. We ask all parents and carers to please read the policy carefully, complete the attached consent form, and return it to school by Friday 8th August.

If we do not receive a completed form by this date, we will assume you are giving permission for the school to take and use images and recordings of your child for school-related purposes, without restriction. Please contact the school if you need help understanding any part of the policy or form.

School Values & Expected Behaviour Matrix

This term, we are revisiting and refreshing our School Wide Positive Behaviour Framework, with a focus on explicitly teaching students what respectful, responsible and safe behaviour looks like across different areas of the school.

We've developed a new School Values Expected Behaviour Matrix, which outlines clear expectations for all students in the classroom, playground, and beyond. A copy of this matrix is included in this newsletter so families can see exactly what we're working on at school and support these expectations at home too. 
